Whereas, Each day, thousands of food service workers serve children in our schools, patients and veterans in our hospitals and nursing homes, and clients in their homes; and

Whereas, In often difficult circumstances, food service workers provide the best available, high-quality food and outstanding service,

Now, Therefore, I, Charles D. Baker, Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, do hereby proclaim October 14th - 18th, 2019, to be,

FOOD SERVICE WORKERS' RECOGNITION WEEK

And urge all the citizens of the Commonwealth to take cognizance of this event and participate fittingly in its observance.
